Rules of Entry and Terms and Conditions

1. To enter participants must be 30 years of age or under at 31 December 2016, currently working full time in the wine industry.
2. To enter the competition participants must be a New Zealand citizen or hold a current New Zealand residency permit.
3. Regional Competitions will be held in Auckland (Northern), Hawkes Bay, Marlborough, Wairarapa and Central Otago. The winner of each regional competition will compete in the Young Viticulturist of the year 2016 National Final held in conjunction with the Romeo Bragato conference in Marlborough. Competition dates 23rd – 25th August 2016
4. A regional event will have no more than eight competitors.
5. In the event of the region accepting entries for more than eight competitors then a selection process will be undertaken. This process will be determined by each region, however preference will be given to those competitors that are closest to 30 years of age.
6. Part of the prize for winning the Regional competition is travel and accommodation expenses up to \$1000 to the National Final as well as registration for Bragato.
7. Those who qualify to enter but live or work outside the four regions where competitions are being held may enter the national competition the following way:
 - Hawke's Bay or Wairarapa will hold a spot open for a Gisborne competitor
 - Marlborough will hold a spot open for a Nelson competitor
 - Central Otago will hold a spot open for a Waipara competitor

Please contact the national co-ordinator to determine the close off dates for out of town competitors.

An out of town competitor cannot win a regional competition, however, they can gain entry to the national competition by being placed in the top three finishes of a regional competition.

An out of town competitor will be eligible for the travel and accommodation packages to the national final, as well as full registration to the Bragato conference.

8. Alternately an out of town competitor can enter the national competition directly, as long as they have the support of their regional winegrower organisation. If a competitor chooses to enter the competition this way, they will need to fund their own travel, accommodation and Romeo Bragato registration.
9. Contestants agree for any photos taken of them during the event to be used in social media and publicity material related to the Young Viticulturist of the Year competition.
10. The national winner – ie The Young Viticulturist of the Year goes on to represent the wine industry in the Young Horticulturist of the Year Competition – 9th-10th November 2016.
11. Contestants enter at their own risk and act in a responsible manner considering the safety of themselves and other contestants and supervisors.
12. During the competition the contestants must wear the competition clothing provided.
13. There is no cash alternative to prizes offered.
14. The contestant must respect all decisions and requests made by the competition supervisors.
